FA1 MA1

About this course

Our introduction to Financial and Management Accounting is the ideal starting point for future business leaders, accountants and entrepreneurs. You don't need any previous knowledge of accounting. Simply sign up and start your journey.

- Business transactions, the banking system and double entry bookkeeping
- Payroll and ledger accounts
- Reconciliation and preparing the trial balance

- How to record and classify costs
- How to use spreadsheets.

Intermediate Financial and Management Accounting

FA2 MA2

About this course

Intermediate Financial and Management Accounting is part of a programme designed for anyone who's just starting out on their accountancy journey. If you have some basic knowledge of accountancy, business and finance, this is the course for you.

What you'll learn

- Widely accepted accounting principles and concepts
- How to prepare a trial balance, journals and ledger accounts
- Reconciliation of control accounts and the cashbook
- Role of costing and the classification of costs
- How to use management accounting to support decision making.

Entry requirements

There are no entry requirements but a basic knowledge of accountancy and business is strongly recommended. If you don't have that, our Introduction course might be a better starting point.

Entry requirements

About this course

What you'll learn

- the principles of making capital investment decisions
- the nature, source and purpose of management information
- cost accounting techniques
- budgets for planning and control
- comparisons and analysis of variances
- performance measurement and monitoring of business performance.

Completion of this course will also prepare you for the ACCA exam 'Management Accounting' (F2 / FMA), one of three exams required to achieve the ACCA Diploma in Accounting and Business.

Financial Accounting

About this course

Learn the underlying concepts behind financial accounting, accounting techniques and the preparation of basic financial statements.

What you'll learn

On completing this course, you will understand:

- how to record, process and report business transactions
- how to use the trial balance and identify and correct errors
- how to prepare simple consolidated financial statements
- the qualitative characteristics of useful information
- · context and purpose of financial reporting
- use of double-entry and accounting systems
- how to prepare basic financial statements for incorporated and unincorporated entities
- interpretation of financial statements.

Completion of this course will also prepare you for the ACCA exam 'Financial Accounting' (FFA / F3), one of three exams required to achieve the ACCA Diploma in Accounting and Business.
