Core Elements

- Pre-congress afternoon: Medical, Leaders & Local Sector Forums
- Welcome Reception & Buffet
- Plenary Welcome, Keynote talk & Panel session
- Four streams:
 - Deep-dive 2-3 hour sessions, workshop style
 - Finalists projects submitted to the Awards
 - Case studies from association executives
 - Demonstrations of technology and AI
- Closing Keynote talk
- Hub for catering & exhibition
- Exhibition with tables



Local Sector Forum (optional)

- Suitable for a destination that has a specific dominant sector or Centres of Excellence in its region.
- The Forum is devised to attract association executives in these sectors, with a view to them placing events with the hosts
- Half-day Forum (3hrs) on Day 0
- Invitations from KOL / VIPs in the sector locally
- Programme developed with KOL / VIP and local experts
- AAE researches potential invitees, with support of local KOL
- No-fee passes to attend this and the whole congress
- Guests fund own hotel bedrooms or a partner sponsors these



Post-Congress Site Visit (optional)

- Open only to delegates with qualified events to contract within 6 months
- Delegates apply, providing details of their event
- 8-20 Association Buyers
- Applicants qualified by hosts or AAE to host's specification
- Programme funded by the hosts / partners:
 - Day 2: Transfers at 17:00, Dinner, 1 night hotel
 - Day 3: breakfast, visits to hotels and other venues, light lunch and transfer to airport

- The host convention bureau bring together partners and sponsors to contribute and take part
- Promotion for other sponsors and partners varies according to the commitment made
- The hosts and local partners exhibit in a dedicated area of the exhibition

OTHER SPONSORS

Always includes:

- Local PCO invited by hosts venue / CVB
OR a PCO partner of AAE

Often include:

- Reception Venue
- Dinner venue
- Hotels (providing low-rate rooms or speaker / organiser bedrooms)
- Coach Transfer provider
- Audio Visual Company
- Catering company
- Signage company

Hosting commitments

Congress

- Main Hub room
- Meeting Rooms
- Conference Office & Press Office
- Catering at the conference venue
- Audio Visual for meeting rooms and the Hub
- Audio facility to make announcements
- Use of any digital signage
- Internet connections for all
- Accept deliveries from organisers and partners the week prior

Social Events

- Welcome Reception with drinks & standing fork buffet
- Congress Party or Dinner (with screen, projector, two microphones and technician for simple awards ceremony)

PCO

- Organising for 8 weeks in advance, onsite and to two weeks after
- Registration & badging
- Organise any transfers and offsite events
- Staffing of each meeting room
- General event staffing
- Overall management

Congress Hotels provide:

- Allocation of 230 rooms 2 nights

And to be a sponsor, provide in total:

- 20 rooms for two nights for speakers
- 10 rooms for three nights for organiser
- 5 rooms for two nights for press



Accommodation requirements

The CVB invites hotels to take part, on the following basis:

- Total allocation: 230 x 2 nights (Day 0 & Day 1)
- Some capacity for arrivals the night prior and the night after
- Modest rate (previously EUR 95 - EUR 140 per night)
- Paid by delegates and exhibitors on booking
- Terms should be: No cancellations in last 6 weeks
- All attendees are required by AAE to book in the congress hotels
- Special link/code to be provided by each hotel
- Hotels to provide booking list to AAE regularly in the lead up for chasing those that have not booked



Audio Visual requirements

For Plenary room and three stream rooms:

- Screen(s) and Projector(s)
- Two lapel radio & one hand-held mic, speakers, amps etc
- Lectern
- Laptop at lectern and at control desk
- Switcher unit for laptop at lectern, speakers' own laptop & laptop at control desk
- Lighting if necessary
- HDMI feed for third-party to record screen and audio
- Staff to control switcher, audio and any other items

Speaker room:

- Laptops x 2 for speakers to submit / check presentations

Hub:

- Microphone and speakers for announcements
- Screens to display rotating slides of what's on next and video of hosts
